HARRY MEAL TILE – HEARING

There were no landowners present. A motion was made by Masters, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Barnes, to set the maintenance assessments at \$8.00 per acre for a period of 2 years. Motion carried.

MEER-STROPPEL TILE & OPEN – HEARING

There were no landowners present. A motion was made by Barnes, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Masters, to set the maintenance assessments at \$2.50 per acre for a period of 3 years. Motion carried.

CHARLES MEYER OPEN DRAIN – HEARING

Interested parties present can be found on the list located in the file in the Surveyor’s office. The Surveyor read his report detailing the work that is needed on this drain. The report can be found in the file in the Surveyor’s office. Mr. Meer was the only person present who was opposed to the proposed work and maintenance assessments. After several questions were asked and answered a motion was made by Barnes, with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Masters, to set the maintenance assessments at \$5.00 per acre for a period of 2 years. Motion carried.
