

Drainage Board met in their regular meeting place in the Rush County courthouse on July 16, 2012 at 10:10 a.m. with the following present: Marvin L. Cole, Ken Masters, members; Leigh Morning, Board attorney; Marvin L. Rees, Surveyor; Michele Gordon, secretary. T.H. Barnes was absent.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved and signed by motion of Masters, with a 2nd by Cole.

ANGLE/VOGEL TILE

Larry Angle is planning to install a drainage system for his property that would be connected to the county tile. The current size of the county tile is not adequate to handle extra water. The Surveyor is suggesting an 8" arm but was told this would be a construction and the landowner would need to file a petition making this request. The Surveyor will talk with Mr. Angle to find out how they would like to proceed.

WM S HALL OPEN

Last year, money from the maintenance fund was used to pay 1/3 of the cost of an experimental 500 foot section of the drain where 3:1 slopes were installed along with a grass mat on the Elbert Gordon property. The work was done to determine whether or not this would help decrease the amount of erosion along the banks of the drain. This seems to be working and now Mr. Gordon is asking to install another 500 feet with the help of paying for the project coming from the maintenance account. A motion was made by Masters, with a 2nd by Cole, to pay 1/2 of the cost of putting in another 500 feet of 3:1 slope and a grass mat. Motion carried. When the maintenance project is being completed this fall on the drain, this area will not need to be done again.

HENRY SCHRADER TILE – HEARING

There were no interested parties present. The Surveyor gave his report which can be found in the file. He also stated that he had received one letter of remonstrance from Mrs. Liggett. A motion was then made by Masters, with a 2nd by Cole, to proceed with the reconstruction of this tile. Motion carried and the Final Order was signed.

There being no further business to come before the Board a motion to adjourn was made by Masters, with a 2nd by Cole. Motion carried.
